

COVID-19 Procedures, Precautions and Restrictions

Service/Activity	Comments
Precautionary Measures in Effect	Follow CDC guidelines and recommendations based on individual conditions.
IL Guest Visitation	No restrictions to visitation in IL.
Assisted Living and Chateau Guest Visitation	Please contact the individual facility to learn more.
Property Entrance and Screening	Residents and partners are permitted to enter property using transponders. All guests and vendors will continue to check-in with the gate guard.
Guest Suites	Shall apply under normal operations.
Campus Transportation	Trams operating at normal capacity.
Meeting Rooms	Meeting spaces may be utilized by residents and staff. Food or beverages may be served at the discretion of the campus Executive Director.
Dining	Orchid Terrace dining room is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
Dining Room Guests	No restrictions to Dining Room guests.
Rejuvenate Salon	No restrictions to Rejuvenate Salon.
Worship Service	Normal Sunday service schedule.
Activities	No restrictions to group activities.
Wellness/Fitness	No restrictions to Wellness/Fitness activities.
Resident Open Forums and Town Meetings	Meetings may occur in-person at maximum capacity.

Positive COVID-19 Test

Some common terms found in our updates are ***Isolation*** and ***Quarantine***. Per the Center for Disease Control (CDC) the definitions are as follows:

- **Isolation** keeps someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 with or without symptoms away from others. Length of isolation is based on your doctors recommendation.
- **Quarantine** keeps someone who was in close contact with a COVID-19 positive individual away from others. Quarantine can end after 14 days or if a negative COVID-19 test was received at the appropriate interval after exposure.

Residents will receive specific information on the supportive services provided by Moorings Park and additional procedure they must follow during isolation or quarantine from the campus Executive Director upon notification of a positive test result.
