**Subj:** Tropical Disturbances

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The National Hurricane Center is tracking several tropical disturbances in the north and central Atlantic, as well as the Caribbean Sea. One such disturbance located just off the coast of Honduras appears to show early signs of a developing tropical depression, and possible hurricane. The National Hurricane Center is encouraging heightened awareness with this specific weather system. So far, there is no storm center to track direction or velocity; however, due to extremely warm oceanic water temperatures, development can occur quickly, much more so than previous seasons. The Collier County Emergency Management Office issued an alert this morning to increase awareness and vigilance. Moorings Park will heed this advice and carefully monitor weather activity throughout the weekend and into early next week. Considering this, please take the time to review your personal plans in the event a rapidly developing hurricane threatens our area.
